LIST welcomes you to the Phytofactories 2023 conference that will take place in Luxembourg City, from the 7th to the 9th of June, 2023. The conference venue is PARC BELLE-VUE PARC PLAZA (Address: 5 Avenue Marie-Thérèse, L-2132 Luxembourg). The location is within walking distance of the Grand Ducal Palace, the “Gëlle Fra” monument, the historic Grund with the Neumünster Abbey and other attractions such as the UNESCO World Heritage “Bock Casemates”.

About Luxembourg

The Grand Duchy of Luxembourg is located at the heart of Europe. It is a multilingual and multicultural country offering plenty of cultural activities and where the everyday life is full of opportunities, socially, politically, and professionally speaking. Despite being one of the smallest members of the European Union (measuring a maximum of 82 km from North to South and 57 km from East to West), Luxembourg is nevertheless the birthplace of the concept of a unified Europe. Together with Brussels and Strasbourg, Luxembourg City is the official headquarter of many of the European Union’s major institutions. The capital is home to several European services and institutions, including services of the European Commission (translation, publication, statistics), the European Court of Auditors, the Court of Justice of the European Union, the European Investment Bank (EIB), the European Investment Fund, the Secretariat of the European Parliament, the European Financial Stability Facility (EFSF) and the European Stability Mechanism (ESM).

The city of Luxembourg was founded in 963. Over the course of its history, Luxembourg has been occupied by Burgundians, Spaniards, French, Austrians and Prussians, all of whom contributed to making it one of the best-fortified cities in the world, the “Gibraltar of the North”. Today, the fortress, along with the Old Town, have gained international recognition.

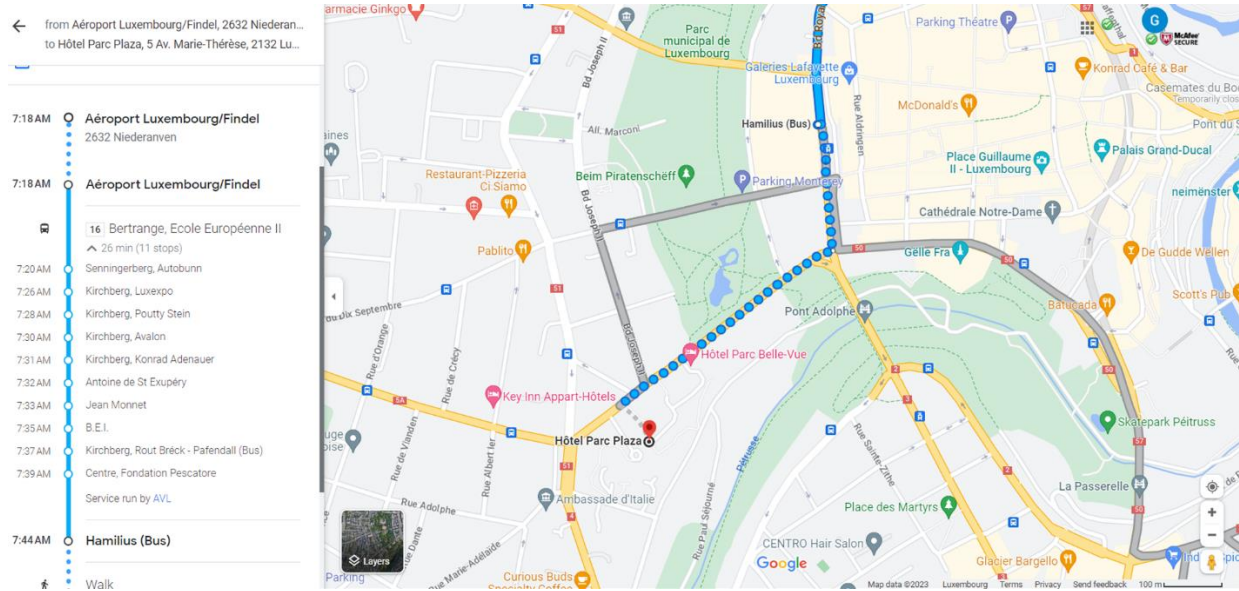


How to get to the meeting venue from Findel Airport

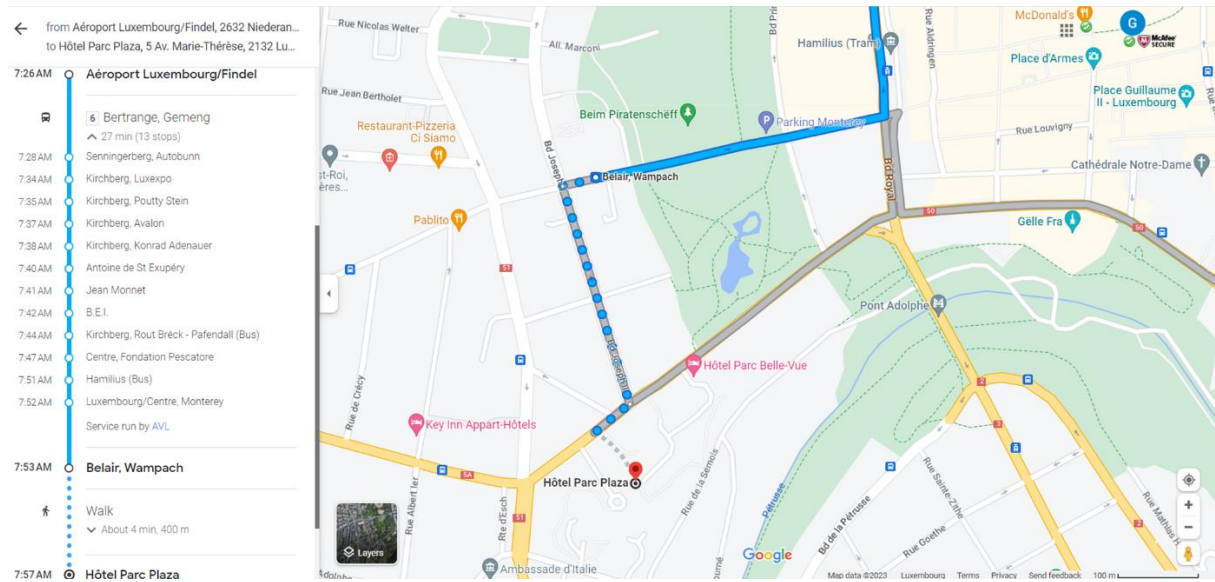
Taxi: approx. 20 minutes, ca. 60-70 EUR.

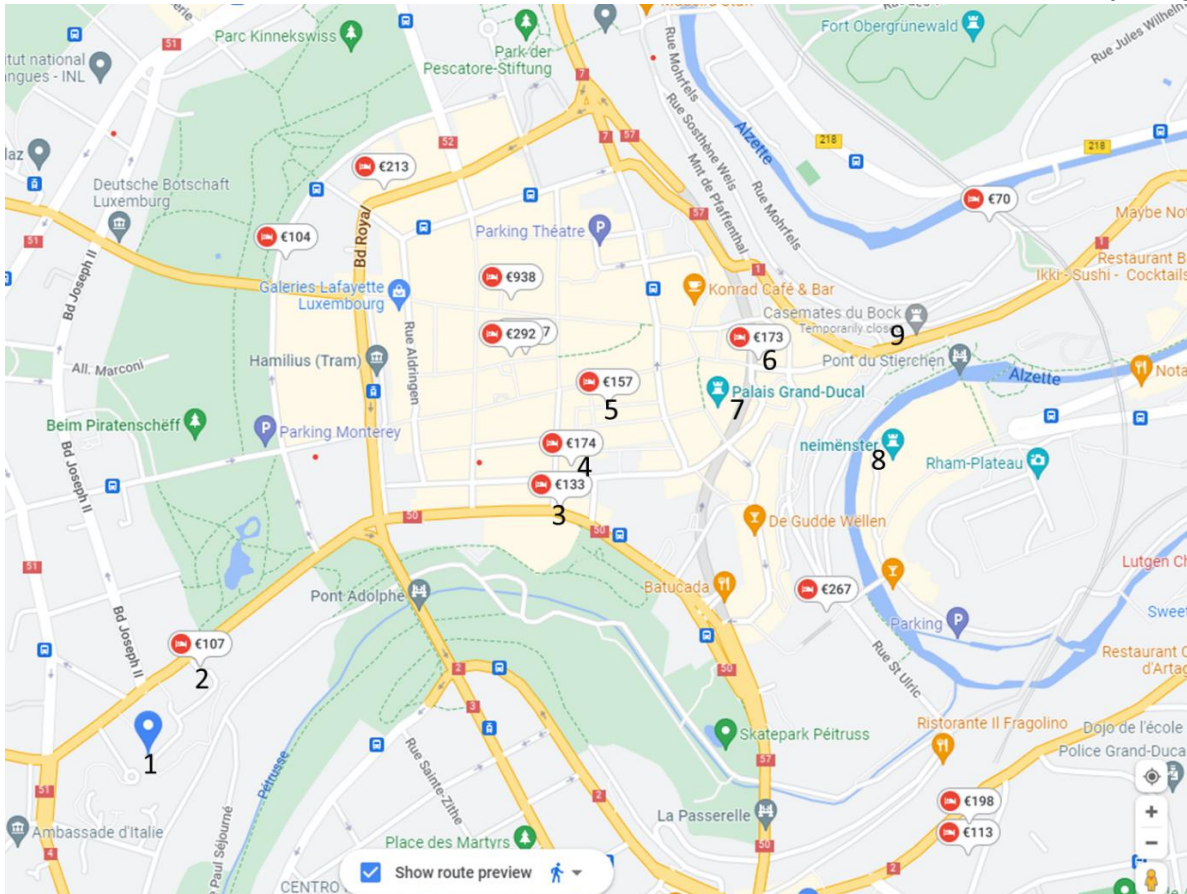
Within Luxembourg, the public means of transport (trains, trams and buses) are free (no ticket required).

Bus n. 16 (direction Bertrange/Ecole Européenne), get off at stop Hamilius, then walk ca. 10 minutes towards venue (see below).



Bus n. 6 (direction Betrange, Gemeng), get off at stop Belair Wampach, then walk ca. 5 minutes towards venue (see below).
